

#### **Features**


- Quickly find printers on a network.


Main Program Window




Start New Scan open a dialog that auto-populates with the first network address range it finds on the machine, and if crossing subnets the scan will automatically skip broadcast addresses.



There is an Administrative Options dialog (Access from scanning menu) that allows setting of a default IP Address range, default SNMP Community name, and adjustment of the wait times if you are running the scan via VPN on a remote network etc. Clicking Save will save the settings to Config.ini in the local directory for future use.
